

Kindness is tender concern for others. It is the desire of a believer to treat others gently, just as the Lord treats him. It is the grace that fills our being softening all within us that would be harsh. It is a tender heart and a NURTURING spirit.

Many of us know far more of God's almighty power and JUDGMENT than we do of His tenderness. God was a Father who knew the INTENSE pain of intense love. Let's look at the following Scriptures.

Matthew 3:17 "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased."

John 17:24 "You loved me before the creation of the world."

Mark 14:36 "Abba Father...Take this cup from me."

If you are a parent, you have experienced fear, pain, and perhaps being rejected, as well as deep love. God understands how you feel if you have a child:

- \* who is rejected by others his own age
- \* who is not beautiful to look upon
- \* who has been betrayed by friends
- \* who has begged yo to fix something you could not fix
- \* who is suffering, dying or have buried a child.

GOD HAS BEEN THERE! Jeremiah 9:24 tells us "let him who boasts boast about this; that he understands and knows me, that I am the Lord who exercises kindness, justice and righteousness on earth, for in these I delight" declares the Lord.

Have you ever felt forgotten by God? Let's read Isaiah 49:14-16.

(v15) Who will forget her child before God will forget His?

(v16) How do we know God will never forget His children?

We know for certain a nursing mother will forget her child before God will forget His own, because their names are forever written in the tender palm of His hand. As a mother many times you have quieted a fearful or fretting child. Rocking them and whispering in their ear "It's OK Mommy's here". Perhaps you sang a song as they begin to rest in your arms. God does that for us. God quiets us with His love.

Do you allow God to nurture you? Do you take your fears and fretting to Him and					
allow Him to hold you in His arms and cover you with His love? I want to share with you					
the story of a boy named Michael.					
We must learn to let God love us as His children. To let Him soothe our feelings when					
when we hurt, our fears when we are scared, and our hearts when they are bleeding. We					
must come to know Christ as a nurturing Father, as well as a Sovereign Judge. Let's look					
once again at the tender heart of the Father.					
Hosea 11:4 tells how God leads us. "I led them with cords of human kindness, with					
ties of love." The nurturing of God is our healing. He takes great delight in caring for					
you. John 3:1 tells us how much our heavenly Father loves us. "How great is the love the					
Father has LAVISHED on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what					
we are!"					
Let's turn from kindness and tenderness to goodness. Goodness is when we are					
energized with BENEVOLENCE, what we'll call active good. Doing something for the					
good or well-being of others. Let's turn in our Bible's to 1 Corinthians 12:4-11.

God did not save us so we could look pretty coming to church on Sunday. No, indeed. God saved us and left us here because He has special work for each of us to do. He has a mission to accomplish for the kingdom in every generation. All of which was planned in advance for us to do.

We are called to do a lot of good or a little. How much good we do depends on our obedience.

Ephesians 2:10 "We are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do". We have not been saved *by* our works—we have been saved *for* His works.

Let's turn in the New Testament to Titus 3:1-8. This is about "Doing What is Good" according to the Bible. This may or may not agree with our culture and the world around us.

It is important to understand that what is good, profitable or BENEFICIAL is not always fun, easy or pleasant. The purpose of this quality of the fruit of the Spirit is to do that which is most beneficial, even if it is not that which is most popular.

A great example of this is found in 2 Timothy 3:16-17. "All Scripture is God breathed and is useful for teaching, REBUKING, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work".
